THE FOLLOWING MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING is an expression of partnership between The Kohima Institute and Phek Government College, entered 1st June, 2018.

Established in 1981 by the people of Phek with the assistance of Shri Lalhuma, IAS, then Deputy Commissioner of Phek, and Shri Vejoi Vero, then Minister of State in Nagaland, Phek Government College is a college affiliated to Nagaland University, and focused on high quality teaching in the arts and sciences. The college currently offers a Bachelor of Arts degree, with B.A. honours offered in Economics, Education, English, History, and Political Science; as well as a Bachelor of Science degree, with B.Sc. honours offered in Botany, Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics, and Zoology.

Founded in 2013, the Kohima Institute is registered as a Public Charitable Trust in Nagaland, and is a research and postgraduate training centre focused on the social sciences, with a broad contextual remit working with minority ethnic communities across highland Asia. The Institute maintains a strong commitment to ethical research practices, and ecological consciousness, promoting indigenous knowledge, philosophies, languages, histories, technologies, and aesthetics. Part of this commitment is the intentional, ongoing resourcing, consultancy work, high-level trainings, and data sharing conducted in conjunction with important research, policy and development initiatives within its region of immediate operation, namely Northeast India.

The Kohima Institute and Phek Government College have identified an opportunity to enhance their perspective roles and effectiveness through a cooperative arrangement that brings together the unique strengths of each organisation. This agreement will provide a bridge for academic excellence, research, staff and student exchange, particularly in regards to internship opportunities, jointly organised events, and other mutually enriching activities.

In this regard, The Kohima Institute and Phek Government College pledge to work together in a spirit of cooperation, learning and support in the following, inter alia, areas, and

- To implement practical means to bring research and teaching closer together;
- To champion inter-sectoral and inter-faculty partnerships to maximise efforts and resources;





- To promote academic research and excellence in the arts and sciences through the sharing of data, publications, information, networks, and resources;
- To provide participatory for fostering innovation and creativity among faculty members, researchers, and students in the arts and sciences; and
- To jointly create opportunities to promote a long-term sustainable continuity of academic interest in research and teaching, and their practical applications in surrounding communities.

This agreement is valid for a period of five years from 1st June 2018, and upon its expiry, can be renewed with the consent of both parties. In addition, this agreement may be amended as mutually agreed upon, or terminated by either party through written notification.

The Kohima Institute and Phek Government College agree to meet annually to review the activities of the prior year and to hold a planning session for the upcoming period.

This agreement does not in any way bind either The Kohima Institute or Phek Government College, nor does it supersede or affect other existing agreements held by either organisation.

Subject: Establishment of New Study Centres of IGNOU - regd.

Sir,

With reference to the above mentioned subject, I would like to bring your kind attention that Indira Gandhi National Open University, established by an Act of Parliament in 1985, serves the educational aspirations of about 1.8 million students in India and 32 countries abroad through 21 Schools of Studies and an elaborate network of 58 Regional Centres (RCs), 7 sub-regional centres, 1804 Study Centres (SCs), and 46 overseas centres. The University is making all efforts to take higher education to the doorsteps of the hitherto un-reached. As of now, about 13% of all students enrolled in higher education in the country are enrolled with IGNOU. Apart from teaching and research, extension, training and other academic activities, it also acts as a national resource centre; and more importantly, functions as an apex body to promote and maintain standards of distance education. The Commonwealth of Learning has recognised it as a centre of excellence. It also has the unique privilege of hosting the Secretariats of SAARC Consortium of Open Distance Learning (SACODiL) and Global Mega Universities Network (GMUNET) promoted by UNESCO.

IGNOU offers 138 academic programmes [list of the various academic programmes of IGNOU enclosed] that are need-based, unconventional, and vocation-oriented with a focus on socio-economic development and serving the dis-advantaged. The programmes are at the awareness, certificate, diploma, degree (Bachelor's, Master's and Doctoral) levels. All the courses are recognized at par with the regular courses of all the Universities in India and are recognized by UGC, NCTE, AIU, AICTE, and other statutory bodies in the respective areas [copy enclosed]. The Government of Nagaland has also recognized all the Degrees, Diplomas & Certificates courses of IGNOU [copy enclosed]

Within India, IGNOU caters to learners from rural and tribal areas, physically-challenged, jail inmates and rehabilitation houses, government and non-government sectors, parents and homemakers, the employers and the employed. The University has put special focus on women, socially and economically disadvantaged groups, the north-east region, and other tribal and low literacy areas of the country.

IGNOU has undertaken a number of major initiatives for the educational development of the North eastern region. It has been executing the North-East Educational Development Project, which is sponsored by Ministry of Human Resource. All the states in the N E have full-fledged IGNOU RCs. SCs of IGNOU have also been set up in all the States. All the RCs have been equipped with EduSat supported Satellite Interactive Terminals. Besides, a number of SCs have also been provided with the same facilities. The university has also created some tailor made training programmes specially designed for the people of the region, e.g., Certificate in Primary Education (CPE), Computer Literacy Programme (CLP), etc. North East Educational Media Focus (NEMFo) is another special initiative undertaken by IGNOU in collaboration with the Electronic Media Production Centre (EMPC), at IGNOU, to train the young film producers from the North East. Basically these films are aimed at capacity building and also to encourage the young professionals to contribute to the making of documentary films related to environment, ecology, social and cultural aspects of North east

Region. Many of these films have been selected for screening at the India International center (IIC), New Delhi and have earned laurels.

The IGNOU Regional Centre in Kohima was established in December 2000. At present, besides the IGNOU Regional Centre in Kohima, there are 12 SCs spread across Nagaland. The RC and the SCs at Nagaland College of Teacher Education and Dimapur Govt. College have been equipped with EduSat. As of now, around 5000 students from Nagaland are enrolled in various programmes of IGNOU. It is expected to grow in future. IGNOU Regional Centre also has a vision to do a lot more for the youth and student community of Nagaland. Various educational programmes/initiatives of IGNOU for Nagaland are considered important in view of lack of sufficient opportunity for higher education in Nagaland, particularly for the poor and underprivileged sections.

In view of the above, IGNOU Regional Centre at Kohima intends to expand its acitivities in Nagaland and establish new IGNOU SCs/Special SCs/Programme SCs in all the districts of Nagaland, depending on the availability of the necessary infrastructure in the Colleges/Institutions. IGNOU SCs are normally established in institutions of higher learning as part time establishments and are normally open in the evenings and on weekends; and work generally outside the working hours of the host institution. The main functions of SCs are to provide academic counseling [by engaging academic counselors approved by IGNOU], to make arrangements for evaluation of assignments for continuous evaluation of students by approved evaluators, to conduct entrance tests and term-end examinations, etc. The SCs are furnished completely at IGNOU's cost and there is no financial obligation on the part of the host institute. However, maintenance of the building is the responsibility of the host institute. The SCs are managed by part time Co-ordinators [responsible for overall, academic, financial and administrative functioning], who are appointed by IGNOU on the recommendations of the Head of the host institute. Co-ordinators report to the Regional Director. Coordinators are supported by Assistant Co-ordinator(s), if necessary, and other part time staff. IGNOU pays remuneration to all the part time staffs, if appointed as per IGNOU norms. Besides, IGNOU pays for all contingent expenses like postage, stationary, payment to counselors, evaluators, and expenses in connection with examinations, etc. Co-ordinators are also given an imprest from which (s)he can meet day to day expenses, as per IGNOU norms.

In this regard, kindly explore the possibility of activating a study centre at your Institution for Phek District. We are enclosing all the necessary documents for activation of an IGNOU Study Centre and request you to kindly forward a proposal for the same. We believe that a collective decision by you and us can be an important step in our endeavour to provide higher education to a large number of poor/deprived/under-privileged students iffour State in General and Phek District in particular.

We look forward to your cooperation and support in this regard.

Programme Activated at Phek Study Centre:

1. MASTER'S DEGREE PROGRAMMES

Master of Arts in Political Science (MPS)

Eligibility: Bachelor's Degree or higher degree from a recognized University.

Duration: Minimum 2 years and maximum 5 years, offered in both January and July cycle of admissions.

Fee Structure: Rs 9000/- for full programme to be paid year wise @Rs.4500/- per year.

2. BACHELOR'S DEGREE PROGRAMME

B.A-(Bachelor of Arts)

Eligibility: 10+2 or its equivalent or BPP from IGNOU

Duration: Minimum 3 years and maximum 6 years, offered both in January and July cycle of admissions.

Fee Structure: Rs.6000/- for full programme to be paid year wise @ 2000/- per year.

BPP-Bachelor's Preparatory Programme (BPP)

Eligibility: No formal Qualification, Minimum age-18 years.

Duration: Minimum 6 months and maximum 2 years, offered in both January and July cycle of admissions.

Fee Structure: Rs.1000/- for full programme.

3. DIPLOMA PROGRAMME

DCE-Diploma in Creative Writing in English

Eligibility: 10+2 or any one without 10+2 but age should be 20 years or above.

Duration: Minimum 1 year and maximum 4, years, offered in both January and July cycle of admissions.

Fee Structure: Rs.3000/- for full programme.

4. CERTIFICATE PROGRAMME

CES-Certificate in Environmental Studies

Eligibility: 10+2 or its equivalent or BPP from IGNOU.

Duration: Minimum 6 months and maximum 2 years, offered in both January and July cycle of admissions.

Fee Structure: Rs.2000/- for full, programme.

CTE-Certificate in Teaching of English as a Second Language.

Eligibility: Graduation or 3 years of B.EL.ED or 2 years PTI,ETT or 10+2 with 2 years teaching experience.

Duration: Minimum 6 months and maximum 2 years, offered in both January and July cycle of admissions.

Fee Structure: Rs.2000/- for full programme.

CYCLE OF ADMISSION:

The University has two cycles of admission —January and July session. The admission for January session are held during September to December and July session admission from May to July or as per the University Directives. There is a minimum and Maximum duration for each courses.

TERM END EXAMINATION(TEE):

Exams are conducted twice a year June and December at IGNOU Study Centres. If the learner is not able to appear Exam in June, then he/she can wait only for six months to appear the exam in December etc. A learner in IGNOU has the flexible option to appear Exams from any existing exam centre in the country. All Certificates/Diplomas/Degrees are recognised at par with the regular programmes of all the Universities in India by UGC, NCTE, AIU, AICTE and other statutory bodies in the respective areas.

NOTE. A student can apply for appearing exam in any exam centre of IGNOU throughout the country.
