
In the academic year 2021, the institution has strived to maintain the institution as a green campus. The institution has organized social work days and cleanliness drives along with the Eco and Sanitation Club of the college, and NSS. During such days, all the students and staff of the institution engages in cleaning the campus, planting trees and flowers etc. For instance, the institution organized a consecutive three days social work from 11th-13th October, 2021. On 11<sup>th</sup> August, 2021, students and teachers potted fifty evergreen plants in the campus premises.

This best practice of the college has also instilled in the students a sense of duty towards the community in maintaining the environment. On 13<sup>th</sup> October, 2021, the students of Phek Government College engaged in social work in Phek Town in collaboration with Nehru Yuva Kendra, Department of Youth Affairs, under the theme "Clean India".


On 14<sup>th</sup> October, 2021, the institution along with a local organization, Phek Town Chakhesang Students Union, participated in a sanitation drive in Phek Town.

The maintenance of green campus, beautification of the campus, cleaning of college buildings and adjoining lawns, maintenance of botanical gardens etc are conducted at regular intervals in congruence with the best practice of the college.


- 2) **Promotion of Skill Development:** Recognizing the unique artistic skills of the students, the institution has adopted the Promotion of skill Development as one of its highly valued best practice. The students are highly skilled in making local handicrafts and indigenous products. Therefore, the institution seeks to promote the skills of the students through various activities which are conducted by the Skill Development Club of the college in consultation with the IQAC. The activities of the clubs focuses on the production and promotion of 100% handcrafted and indigenous products such as traditional bamboo baskets, wooden tables and spoons, traditional machetes, decorative items, hand woven bags, sieving tray etc. The handcrafted products and items of the students are displayed in the college, and also put up in stalls for display and sale during Independence Day and Republic Day celebrations in the district.
