












Minutes of the IQAC Meeting

The IQAC convened a meeting on 23rd September 2025, chaired by Dr. Levinu Sakhrie, IQAC Coordinator, who introduced the meeting. The following key issues were discussed and resolutions adopted:

1. Orientation on NAAC Criteria: Dr. Levinu Sakhrie proposed organising a brief orientation session covering the seven NAAC criteria and essential information regarding IQAC and its Steering Committee. The proposal was unanimously approved by the house.
2. Proposal for an Educational Park: The house discussed the creation of an educational park aimed at promoting environmental awareness and recycling. The following action plans were outlined:
 - a) NCC Cadets will conduct a social work activity at the proposed site on 26th September 2025.
 - b) Heads of Departments (HoDs) will meet with their respective departments to finalise the model/structure ideas and submit them to Dr. Neisekphoto Nisa, Convenor- Skill Development Club by 26th September 2025.
 - c) Town Committee to provide 300 plastic bottles to be used in constructing the models.
3. Mobilisation for Science Stream: To encourage enrolment in the Science stream, the following initiatives were approved:
 - a) College representatives will visit Government Higher Secondary School, Phek Town in October 2025, presenting promotional materials via PowerPoint.
 - b) A Science Exhibition will be held with a grand opening on National Science Day (28th February 2026), in collaboration with PTCSU and organised by the Science Club, PGC. Advance notice will be issued this year, targeting both high school and higher secondary students.
4. Proposal for Postgraduate Programmes: HoDs are requested to submit details regarding sanctioned posts and faculty requirements to the Principal. A proposal will be forwarded for initiating PG programmes in at least two departments: Political Science and History.
Additionally, all HoDs are requested to submit their department routine to Mr. Neiwe Mero at the earliest.
5. College Fest: The house tentatively scheduled the College Fest for the third week of October 2025. A follow-up meeting will be held to finalise details with the concerned committee members.
6. Hostel Regulations: The Hostel Committee and Disciplinary Committee are instructed to draft a comprehensive set of rules and regulations for the College Boys' Hostel at the earliest.
7. Durga Puja Break: It was decided that the Durga Puja break will be kept from 1st to 6th October 2025, with regular classes resuming on 7th October 2025.
